AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN ROADS ON THE GROUNDS OR PROPERTY OF CERTAIN STATE HOSPITALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 123 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 8A and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 8A.* The department of public works shall construct
5 and maintain roads on the grounds or property of a state
6 hospital, and expenses so incurred shall be paid from appro-

ACT REGARDING THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR
AND MAINTAINING THE COURSE OF THE
OF CERTAIN STATE INSTITUTIONS

As it relates to the Department of the Interior
and the maintenance of the same, as
follows:

1. Chapter 113 of the Revised Laws of 1900 be amended by striking out section 35 and inserting in lieu thereof the following section:
2. Section 35. The Department of the Interior shall maintain and repair in the grounds of generally as a site a hospital and infirmary or hospital and infirmary for the treatment of such patients.
