AN ACT REQUIRING EVERY POLICE OFFICER TO WEAR CERTAIN IDENTIFICATION MATERIAL ON HIS UNIFORM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 96B the following section: —
- 3 *Section 96C.* Every police officer or other person empowered
- 4 to make arrests who is employed by any city or town shall be
- 5 required to wear a badge, tag or label which identifies him by
- 6 name and which carries his photograph and a facsimile of the
- 7 city seal.
