AN ACT DELETING AN UNNECESSARY SENTENCE FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW REGARDING REQUISITIONS NOT ESPECIALLY CALLING FOR WOMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of chapter 31 of the General Laws as inserted by
2 section 5 of chapter 627 of the acts of 1954 is hereby
3 amended by striking out the sentence, "Upon receipt of a
4 requisition not especially calling for women, names shall be
5 certified from such lists according to the method of certifica-
6 tion prescribed by the civil service rules applying to civilians",
7 as appearing in lines 10 through 13.
