

HOUSE No. 3916

By Mr. Grosso of Shrewsbury, petition of Anthony P. Grosso and another for legislation to authorize the town of Shrewsbury and the Department of Mental Health to enter into an agreement for the use of the Shrewsbury sewer system by said department. Social Welfare. [Local Approval Required.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF THE SHREWSBURY SEWER SYSTEM BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Board of Sewer Commission and the Com-
2 missioner of Mental Health shall execute an agreement to
3 provide for the payment by the Commonwealth to the town in
4 lieu of a sewer assessment and annual sewer use charges on
5 property owned by the Commonwealth on the Boston Turn-
6 pike and Lake Street, known as Hillside Farm.

1 SECTION 2. This agreement shall become effective when
2 the Department of Mental Health makes connections from
3 buildings on said property to the town sewer system.

The Constitution of the State

As amended by the Legislature

ARTICLE I. The legislative power shall be vested in the Legislature, which shall consist of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

SECTION 1. The Senate shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State for a term of four years.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State for a term of two years.

SECTION 3. The Legislature shall assemble on the first Monday in January of each year.
