RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING DAY CARE CENTERS FOR THE ELDERLY.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the feasibility of day care centers for the
6 elderly which would provide convalescent, health and geriatric
7 facilities.
