AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERKS IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 2 of chapter 585 of the acts of
3 1970, is hereby further amended by inserting after the ninth
4 paragraph the following paragraph: —

5 A sixth and seventh assistant clerk with salaries payable by
6 the county may be appointed, subject to the approval of the
7 county commissioners, in the district court of Springfield.
