AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP CURRICULUM MATERIALS ON THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF DRUGS AND ALCOHOL FOR USE IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 3 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 3A.* The department of education shall develop
- 4 curriculum materials concerning education on the harmful
- 5 effects of drugs and alcohol and such curriculum materials shall
- 6 be adopted and used as the basis of courses of instruction in all
- 7 the public schools of the commonwealth. The said department
- 8 shall also institute and hold in-service training programs for
- 9 teachers of said courses.
