AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR PAROLE FOR PRISONERS WHO HAVE SERVED TEN YEARS IN STATE PRISON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any
- 2 prisoner in state prison who has served ten years, shall be
- 3 eligible for parole irrespective of length of his sentence.
