AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR ONE HALF THE COST OF MAINTAINING DRUG PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 10 the following section: —

3 *Section 10A.* The commonwealth shall reimburse cities and
4 towns for one half the cost of maintaining centers to prevent
5 the use of harmful drugs and to provide assistance to rehabilitate
6 the users of harmful drugs.
