

ACTS, 1980. - Chaps. 50, 51, 52.

Chap. 50. AN ACT CONFORMING THE CHARGING OF CERTAIN UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS IN CONFORMITY WITH FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 4 of the acts of 1978 is hereby amended by striking out the fifth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

All payments for the first week of the period designated in the first paragraph of this act to employees made eligible for benefits solely because of the provisions of said paragraph shall be charged to the appropriate solvency account established pursuant to the provisions of sections fourteen and fourteen C of said chapter one hundred and fifty-one A; provided, that this provision shall not apply in the case of employers who finance benefits pursuant to section fourteen A of said chapter one hundred and fifty-one A. All other payments for said period to employees experiencing total or partial unemployment because of severe weather conditions or any prohibition on travel by any public official or body, shall be charged in accordance with the provisions of section fourteen or fourteen A or fourteen C of said chapter one hundred and fifty-one A.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of February sixteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.

Chap. 51. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTINUED APPROPRIATION FOR THE WEBB PARK IN THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Item 2120-8775 of section 4 of chapter 481 of the acts of 1976, as amended by section 2 of chapter 905 of the acts of 1977, is hereby further amended by striking out the wording and inserting in place thereof the following:- For conservation and recreational development of the former Weymouth Nike missile site, land, leased or owned with buildings thereon, and property adjacent thereto, to be in addition to any funds otherwise available.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
