*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 76 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended in section 8 of chapter 845 of the acts of  
3 1969, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 1 and  
4 2 the words "twenty-six thousand and three hundred dollars"  
5 and inserting in place thereof the words: — thirty-two thousand  
6 dollars.

- 4 2 the words 'prisoner brought and there held in custody'
- 5 and inserting in place thereof the words - 'detainee brought
- 6 and held'.
