By Mr. Brett of Quincy, petition of Joseph E. Brett and another for legislation to prohibit the expenditure of public funds for the installation of water or sewer utilities or any other public improvements on filled land of an owner or developer. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER OR SEWER UTILITIES OR ANY OTHER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS ON FILLED LAND OF AN OWNER OR DEVELOPER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, land
- 2 which has been filled by an owner or developer shall not by
- 3 the expenditure of any public funds have water or sewer
- 4 utilities or any other public improvement installed therein.
