In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

### AN ACT CREATING A BOARD OF TRUSTEES AT THE STATE COLLEGE IN SALEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 73 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 19 the following section: —

3 *Section 19A.* Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
4 contrary, there shall be a board of trustees at the state college  
5 in Salem to consist of eleven persons, seven of whom shall be  
6 appointed by the governor for a term of four years, two of  
7 whom shall be elected by the alumni association for a term of  
8 two years, one of whom shall be a student elected by the  
9 student association for a term of one year and one of whom  
10 shall be a resident of the city of Salem elected by the city  
11 council of said city for a term of four years.
