INSURANCE PREMIUMS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 164 and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section: —
- 4 *Section 164.* A collector of premiums who does not solicit
- 5 application for or the renewal or continuance of insurance
- 6 contracts, or act or aid in negotiating such contracts or the
- 7 continuance or renewal thereof, may carry on such business
- 8 without a license therefor.
