AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE QUESTION OF TRANSFERRING CERTAIN FUNDS OF THE TOWN OF DRACUT TO THE SECONDARY LEVEL SCHOOL BUILDING COMMITTEE OF SAID TOWN SHALL BE PLACED ON THE OFFICIAL BALLOT OF SAID TOWN IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In the town of Dracut at its annual town
2 meeting to be held in March in the current year there shall be
3 submitted for acceptance to the voters of said town the follow-
4 ing question which shall be placed upon the official ballot to
5 be used for the election of town officers: -

6 "Shall the Town transfer the \$25,000.00 (twenty five thou-
7 sand dollars) voted under article No. 46 at the Annual Town
8 Meeting in March, 1970 to the Secondary Level School Build-
9 ing Committee to be expended by said Committee for engineer-
10 ing, architectural, administrative and legal services associated
11 with the planning and construction of a new Senior High
12 School for the Town of Dracut?"

13 If a majority of votes in answer to said question is in the
14 affirmative, the proposal shall deem to be adopted, and if said
15 majority is in the negative the proposal shall deem to be
16 rejected.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
