AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REFERRAL OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS TO ARBITRATION PROCEDURES BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIVERSION OF WATERS OF THE CONNECTICUT RIVER INTO QUABBIN RESERVOIR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 669 of the acts of 1967,
2 as amended by section 1A of chapter 766 of the acts of 1970,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "ac-
4 quired" at the end of the first sentence in section 1A of said
5 chapter 766 the following sentence: — In entering into the
6 aforesaid agreements the parties thereto may include therein
7 provisions for the referral of disagreements and disputes to
8 arbitration procedures.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
