The committee on Public Service to whom was referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3472) of George Keveryan that compensation paid to police officers and fire fighters for holiday service shall be included as regular compensation for deduction purposes toward retirement for members of the contributory and non-contributory retirement system, report recommending that the bill accompanying said petition ought to pass, as changed by substituting a new draft entitled: An Act providing that compensation paid to police officers and fire fighters for holiday service shall be included as regular compensation toward retirement for members of the non-contributory retirement system (House, No. 5036).

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT COMPENSATION PAID TO POLICE OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS FOR HOLIDAY SERVICE SHALL BE INCLUDED AS REGULAR COMPENSATION TOWARD RETIREMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE NON-CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding after section 85J a new section 85K as follows: —

3 *Section 85K.* The annual rate of regular compensation as
4 used in sections 80 through 85J, inclusive, shall include money
5 paid for service rendered on holidays.
