AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CERTIFICATION OF NAMES TO FILL CIVIL SERVICE POSITIONS WHEN THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE HAS WAIVED RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 8B, as amended by chapter 6 of
3 the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 *Section 8B.* The director may waive domiciliary requirements
6 in any examination for any person who has successfully
7 completed at least one academic year at a recognized college or
8 university in the commonwealth, provided such person meets all
9 other entrance requirements.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 31 is hereby further amended by
2 striking out section 19, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
3 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 19.* Except as otherwise provided by law, in all
5 positions, employments and work in any branch of the service of
6 the commonwealth, or of any county, city, town or district
7 therein, persons who are domiciled in the commonwealth shall be
8 given preference; provided, when the director waives domiciliary
9 requirements in accordance with the civil service rules or the
10 provisions of section 8B, any person who does not have a
11 domicile in the commonwealth and who otherwise qualifies shall
12 be placed on the eligible list in accordance with the civil service
13 law and rules.
