AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELIMINATING DISCRIMINATION IN CREDIT, SERVICES OR RENTAL ACCOMMODATIONS TO CERTAIN RECIPIENTS OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 151B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after subsection (9) the following sub-
3 section:—

4 (10). For any person furnishing credit, services or renting
5 accommodations to discriminate against any individual who is a
6 recipient of federal, state or local public assistance, including
7 medical assistance, or who is a tenant receiving federal, state or
8 local housing subsidies, including rental assistance or rent
9 supplements, because of such individual's status as such recipient.

Information of the House is given to the Senate by the
Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives
in its report on the bill for the relief of the
said Senator.
