AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH THE TOWN OF BOURNE MAY EXPEND FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 124 of the acts of 1952 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 1, as most recently amended by
3 chapter 33 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section: — *Section 1.* The town of Bourne may
5 annually appropriate a sum, not exceeding eighty-five hundred
6 dollars, for the purpose of advertising the advantages of the
7 town, with special reference to its facilities for summer vacation,
8 recreation, seashore, residential and small manufacturing pur-
9 poses. The money so appropriated shall be expended under the
10 direction of the selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
