AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN SEWER ASSESSMENTS IN THE TOWN OF SCITUATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the failure of the town of Scituate to comply
2 with the provisions of section eight of chapter six hundred and
3 thirty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, all
4 assessments made by said town as a result of its adoption of said
5 chapter six hundred and thirty-six are hereby validated and
6 confirmed as if said section eight had been complied with at the
7 time of said assessments.
