AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE TENEMENT HOUSE ACT SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE TOWN OF STONEHAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The provisions of chapter one hundred and forty-five of the
- 2 General Laws, relative to tenement houses in towns, shall not
- 3 apply in the town of Stoneham notwithstanding the acceptance
- 4 of chapter six hundred and thirty-five of the acts of nineteen
- 5 hundred and twelve by said town.
