

By Mr. Manning of Milton, presented a petition of M. Joseph Manning (by vote of the town) relative to the granting of licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to apartment houses having a dining room capacity of not less than ninety-nine persons in the town of Milton. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO APARTMENT HOUSES HAVING A DINING ROOM CAPACITY OF NOT LESS THAN NINETY-NINE PERSONS IN THE TOWN OF MILTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitations imposed by
2 section eleven or eleven A of chapter one hundred and thirty-
3 eight of the General Laws as to the time and manner of voting
4 upon the questions therein set forth, the selectmen of the town
5 of Milton shall cause to be placed on the official ballot used in
6 the town of Milton by the registered voters of the town of Milton
7 at the annual town meeting to be held in the year nineteen
8 hundred and seventy-two the following question to wit:

9 Shall licenses be granted in the town of Milton
10 for the sale therein of all alcoholic beverages to be
11 consumed on the premises of apartment houses
12 having a dining room with a capacity of not less than ninety-nine
13 persons?

14 If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to said
15 question is in the affirmative, said town shall be taken to have
16 authorized, until the end of calendar year nineteen hundred and
17 seventy-two, the sale in said town of all alcoholic beverages to be
18 drunk on the premises of apartment houses having a dining room
19 capacity of not less than ninety-nine persons in accordance with
20 the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 2. The state secretary shall cause to be placed on
2 the official ballot used in the town of Milton at each biennial
3 state election the following subdivision to the question which he
4 is required under the provisions of section eleven of chapter one
5 hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to place on the
6 official ballot in all cities and towns at such elections, to wit:

7 E. Shall licenses be granted in the town of
8 Milton for the sale therein of all alcoholic
9 beverages to be consumed on the premises to

10 apartment houses having a dining room capacity of not less than
11 ninety-nine persons;

12 If a majority of the votes cast in such town in answer to
13 subdivision E is in the affirmative, such town shall, irrespective of
14 the result of the votes in answer to subdivisions A, B, C and D, be
15 taken to have authorized, for the two calendar years next
16 succeeding, the retail sale in such town of all alcoholic beverages
17 to be drunk on the premises of apartment houses having a dining
18 room capacity of not less than ninety-nine persons in accordance
19 with the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.
