AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF AENEAS M.
CASEY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,*

follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or
2 special law to the contrary, the city of Cambridge through its
3 retirement board is hereby authorized to grant to Aeneas M.
4 Casey, a former police officer, who is presently retired from said
5 city, a non-contributory pension based on the current rate of
6 regular pay in such an amount as is provided for police officers
7 under section eighty-three A of chapter thirty-two of the General
8 Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Cambridge and the pension authorized by section one
3 of this act shall be paid on and after said effective date.
