AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF A SUM OF MONEY TO THE TOWN OF AGAWAM AS PARTIAL REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSE INCURRED AS A RESULT OF A TORNADO.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The commonwealth shall reimburse the town of Agawam the
- 2 sum of forty-one hundred dollars as partial payment of expense
- 3 incurred by said town in repairing damage caused by the tornado
- 4 of October third, nineteen hundred and seventy.
