

By Mr. Daly of Boston, petition of Herbert P. Gleason and Michael J. Daly (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to provide for the recognition of certain teaching service in the Boston public schools as creditable service under certain retirement systems. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECOGNITION OF CERTAIN TEACHING SERVICE IN THE BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS AS CREDITABLE SERVICE UNDER CERTAIN RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any person who, on the effective date of this act, is a member
2 of the State-Boston retirement system, and who, at any time
3 between September first, nineteen hundred and thirty-three, and
4 August thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, rendered
5 service as a teaching assistant or candidate in training in a public
6 school of the city of Boston for which he either received no
7 compensation or was paid at the rate of fifty cents a day may,
8 within one year from said effective date or such further time as
9 the Boston retirement board, in the event of obvious hardship,
10 may in its discretion allow, pay into the annuity savings fund of
11 said retirement system in one sum, or in installments upon such
12 terms and conditions as said retirement board may prescribe,
13 make-up payments in a sum equal to five per cent of his
14 compensation for services so rendered during said period,
15 together with regular interest thereon. Upon the completion of
16 such make-up payments, such member shall receive, for the
17 purposes of retirement under the Boston retirement system or
18 the State-Boston retirement system, as the case may be, or under
19 section fifty-seven or fifty-eight of chapter thirty-two of the
20 General Laws, the same credit for services so rendered as would
21 have been allowed had such services been rendered by him for

22 regular compensation. In the event any retirement allowance
23 becomes effective prior to the completion of such make-up
24 payments, such member shall, in addition to credit for his actual
25 membership service, be entitled to credit for that proportion of
26 service rendered by him as aforesaid which the total amount of
27 his make-up payments actually made, together with regular
28 interest thereon to the date his retirement allowance becomes
29 effective, bears to the total amount of what his make-up
30 payments, together with regular interest thereon to such latter
31 date, would have been had he made payment thereof in one sum
32 on such latter date.
