## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A ONE YEAR RESIDENCY IN THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR WELFARE ASSISTANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subsection (A) of section 2 of chapter 18 of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1967, is  
3 hereby amended by adding after the word "program", in line 2,  
4 the following words: — for persons who have been residents of  
5 the commonwealth for one year or more.
