AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ACCESS ROAD IN
THE TOWN OF CLINTON FROM ROUTE 495 TO ROUTE 70.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,*
follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct in the town of Clinton an access road from
- 3 route 495 to route 70. Said department shall expend for said
- 4 purposes such sums as may be available under the provisions of
- 5 chapter six hundred and sixteen of the acts of nineteen hundred
- 6 and sixty-seven.
