AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN TO ESTABLISH IN THE TOWN TREASURY A MUNICIPAL SKATING ARENA COMMITTEE REVOLVING FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Watertown may establish in the town treasury a
2 revolving fund in which shall be deposited the receipts of the
3 municipal skating arena committee, said fund to be held as a
4 separate account and expended by said committee from time to
5 time without further appropriation, notwithstanding the pro-
6 visions of section fifty-three of chapter forty-four of the General
7 Laws.
