**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PARTICIPATE IN CERTAIN COOPERATIVE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL RESOURCE AND CONSERVATION DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subject to appropriation, the department of public works is  
2 hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the United States  
3 Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service, for the  
4 performance of work necessary on Resource Conservation and  
5 Development projects approved for the commonwealth. These  
6 agreements are limited to those for which the Soil Conservation  
7 Service is authorized to share in the installation cost, including  
8 flood prevention measures, agricultural water management, ero-  
9 sion and sediment control measures, fish and wildlife measures  
10 and recreation development.

11 In any project undertaken under the authority of this act, the  
12 department is authorized to transfer the Commonwealth's share  
13 of funds to the United States Department of Agriculture, Soil  
14 Conservation Service, where that agency of the federal govern-  
15 ment is the contracting agency for the project.
