AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH TO USE FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT PURPOSES CERTAIN LAND IN SAID CITY NOW HELD AS CITY FORESTRY LAND AND DEDICATED TO USE AS A PUBLIC DOMAIN.
