AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE POSTING OF FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 10A the following section: —

3 *Section 10B.* Selectmen in towns, and the aldermen or other
4 board or officer having charge of ways in cities and towns, may
5 by regulation subject to the provisions of section 2, authorize the
6 posting of four-way stop signs at certain intersections under their
7 jurisdiction.
