AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FREE ADMISSION TO RECREATION AREAS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS AND CERTAIN HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 41 of chapter 92 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding the following sentence: — A disabled veteran or a
4 handicapped person whose vehicle bears the distinctive number
5 plate authorized by section two of chapter ninety shall not be
6 required to pay the charges established under the provisions of
7 this section.

1 SECTION 2. Subdivision (2) of section 2D of chapter 132A of
2 the General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 656 of the
3 acts of 1958, is hereby amended by adding the following
4 sentence: — A disabled veteran or a handicapped person whose
5 vehicle bears the distinctive number plate authorized by section
6 two of chapter ninety shall not be required to pay the charges or
7 fees imposed under the provisions of this subdivision.
