AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TAUNTON TO PAY CERTAIN MEMBERS OF ITS FIRE DEPARTMENT CERTAIN AWARDS GRANTED TO THEM BY AN ARBITRATOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Taunton is hereby authorized to pay
2 to the following members of its fire department the following
3 sums which sums represent awards granted to each of them as a
4 result of arbitration due to a labor dispute which arose prior to
5 the year nineteen hundred and seventy-one under a contract
6 between said city and the International Association of Fire-
7 fighters, Local 1391: —
