## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT REGULATING THE TYPE OF REFLECTIVE MATERIAL REQUIRED TO BE PLACED ON THE REAR OF OUTSIDE REAR VIEW MIRRORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 206 of the Acts of 1971, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting after the 13th sentence, inserted by  
4 chapter 206 of the Acts of 1971, the following sentence:

5 Such reflective material shall comply with such minimum  
6 standards for construction and performance as the Registrar may  
7 prescribe.

Section 1 of Chapter 100 of the General Laws, as amended, is amended by chapter 236 of the Acts of 1971, to read as follows:
