**RESOLUTIONS COMMENDING DR. GEORGE E. FROST, PRESIDENT OF HOLYOKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.**

1     *Whereas*, On Friday evening, October 22, 1971, the Holyoke  
2 Community College Alumni Association will honor Dr. George E.  
3 Frost, President of Holyoke Community College, for 25 years of  
4 devoted and progressive leadership as Head of the College, first as  
5 its Director when it first started as the Holyoke Junior College  
6 and then its President when it became a Community College; and

7     *Whereas*, Founded in 1946 as a Junior College with an initial  
8 enrollment of 85 students, Holyoke Community College under  
9 the inspirational leadership and guidance of Dr. George E. Frost  
10 has taken a respected position in the academic field, and in  
11 December, 1970, was granted full accreditation for maximum  
12 term by the New England Association of Colleges and Secondary  
13 Schools, and now has a total enrollment in the day and evening  
14 division of 3,584 students; and

15     *Whereas*, In the performance of his many exacting duties as  
16 President of Holyoke Community College, Dr. Frost has earned  
17 the respect and esteem of the professional educators with whom  
18 he came in contact, is an outstanding citizen in his community  
19 and actively participates in many civic, educational, religious and  
20 fraternal organizations; therefore be it

21     *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives is  
22 happy to join in the recognition of this worthy, public servant,  
23 extends to Dr. George E. Frost its congratulations on his  
24 achievements and wishes good health and success in all his future  
25 endeavors; and be it further

26     *Resolved*, That a copy of these restrictions be forwarded by  
27 the Secretary of the Commonwealth to Dr. George E. Frost.
