AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO GRANT CERTAIN SALARY INCREASES RETROACTIVE TO JULY FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provision of section thirty-three A of  
2 chapter forty-four of the General Laws or of any other law, the  
3 city of Malden is hereby authorized to enact an ordinance in-  
4 creasing the salaries or compensation of its employees retroactive  
5 to July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, subject, how-  
6 ever, to the rules and regulations of the Office of Emergency  
7 Preparedness established under authority of Presidential Order  
8 11615.

The Municipality of Berlin

Article 1. The Municipality of Berlin is established.

Article 2. The Municipality of Berlin shall have the same powers and prerogatives as the municipalities of the Kingdom of Prussia.
