

By Mr. Aguiar of Swansea, petition of Antone S. Aguiar, Jr. (by vote of the town) for legislation to validate the action of the town of Swansea in granting retroactive pay raises to all permanent custodians of the school department of said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTION OF THE TOWN OF SWANSEA IN GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY RAISES TO ALL PERMANENT CUSTODIANS OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the
2 contrary, the town of Swansea, at a special town meeting called
3 for that purpose, may approve a collective bargaining contract by
4 and between said town and the American Federation of State,
5 County and Municipal employees for all permanent custodians of
6 the school department of said town, granting them certain wage
7 and fringe benefits retroactive to January first, nineteen hundred
8 and seventy-one, to be met by the school salary account, subject,
9 however, to the rules and regulations of the Office of Emergency
10 Preparedness established under the authority of Presidential
11 Order 11615.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken by the town of Swansea at the
2 special town meeting held on November first, nineteen hundred
3 and seventy-one, shall be as valid and effective as though section
4 one of this act had been in full force and effect at the time of the
5 posting of the warrant for said meeting.

By the Order of the Senate, petition of August 2, 1905, is the vote of the town for resolution to require the action of the town of Swanton in granting retroactive pay rates to all permanent employees of the school department of said town. Local Affairs [Local Approval Required].

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN LEGISLATIVE COURT assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 for that purpose, may report a collective bargaining contract for
- 4 and between said town and the American Education of State,
- 5 County and Municipal employees for all permanent employees of
- 6 the school department of said town, granting them certain wage
- 7 and fringe benefits retroactive to January first, nineteen hundred
- 8 and twenty-one, to be set by the school committee, subject,
- 9 however, to the rules and regulations of the Office of Emergency
- 10 Management established under the authority of Presidential
- 11 Order 11617.

- 4 one of this act had been in full force and effect at the time of the
