AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF PORTIA LAW SCHOOL TO NEW ENGLAND SCHOOL OF LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of Portia Law School, a corporation
2 incorporated by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the Special
3 Acts of nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby changed to
4 New England School of Law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
