In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING MULTI-SERVICE CENTERS FOR THE ELDERLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The second paragraph of section 3 of chapter 23B of the
- 2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following
- 3 clause: —
- 4 (u) establish in each county, in conjunction with federal
- 5 programs and available federal funds, a multi-service center
- 6 for the elderly for the purpose of assisting such persons in
- 7 securing proper medical treatment, adequate housing, recrea-
- 8 tional opportunities, and information pertinent to problems of
- 9 the elderly.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR FOR THE UNITED STATES

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The several provisions of section 2 of chapter 222 of the General Laws are hereby amended by adding the following clause:—

1. (a) to establish in each county in cooperation with (b) a program and establish a fund for a similar fund in (c) for the study for the purpose of making such persons in (d) with proper medical treatment, adequate housing, (e) local organizations, and information pertinent to problems of (f) disability.
