SENATE No. 56

By Mr. Harmon, a petition of Samuel Harmon for legislation to establish the Commonwealth school of nursing. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE COMMONWEALTH SCHOOL OF NURSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 17 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after Section 6B, inserted by section 1 of chapter 713 of
3 the acts of 1966, the following section: —
- 4 *Section 6C.* The department shall maintain a nursing school
5 to be known as the Commonwealth School of Nursing in a suit-
6 able location in the city of Boston. Said school shall be so
7 maintained and operated in co-operation with existing nursing
8 schools so as to comply with the standards approved by nation-
9 ally recognized nursing schools in the commonwealth. Said
10 department shall make plans and may accept grants or match-
11 ing funds that are available or may become available from the
12 federal government or any other source, public, or private, for
13 constructing, financing, equipping, improving or expanding said
14 nursing school.

The Appropriations of the State

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two

- AND FOR ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION AND SALARIES OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE AND THE CITY OF BOSTON.
- Section 90. The department shall maintain a working school to be known as the Commonwealth School of Boston in a self-contained and operated in an apartment building with existing municipal buildings as to comply with the standards approved by the State Board of Education in the department. Said department shall make plans and may accept grants or moneys from the Federal Government or any other source public or private for constructing, financing, equipping, improving or expanding said working school.
