AN ACT AUTHORIZING SALARY DIFFERENTIALS TO BE PAID PROFESSIONAL NURSES EMPLOYED AT THE LEMUEL SHATTUCK HOSPITAL AND SOLDIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of Sections 45-50 inclusive
2 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, the salary differential is
3 hereby authorized to be paid to employees in the nursing
4 services who are employed on evening or night tours of duty
5 and to employees engaged in professional nursing as defined
6 in Section 80B of Chapter 112 of the General Laws at the
7 Lemuel Shattuck Hospital and the Soldiers' Home in Massa-
8 chusetts. Any salary differential authorized by this section
9 shall be paid in accordance with rules and regulations estab-
10 lished by the director of personnel and standardization with
11 the approval of the commissioner of administration. Such
12 rules and regulations shall not be subject to chapter 30A of
13 the General Laws.
