**AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CHARGE FOR A BETTERMENT  
LIEN CERTIFICATE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The last sentence of Section 12 of Chapter 80 of the General
- 2 Laws shall be changed to read "The collector of taxes shall
- 3 charge four dollars for each certificate so issued, and the
- 4 money so received shall be paid into the town treasury".

By the Senate (by request) a portion of the Massachusetts Collection and Treasurer's Association to William S. Chapman for legislation to increase the charge for a permanent license for taxation.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CHARGE FOR A PERMANENT

LICENSE

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1 The last sentence of Section 32 of Chapter 80 of the General Laws shall be changed to read: "The collector of taxes shall charge four dollars for each certificate so issued, and the amount so received shall be paid into the town treasury."
