RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ENCOURAGING COMMERCIAL AIRLINES AND RAILROADS TO ESTABLISH REDUCED FARES FOR ELDERLY PERSONS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three mem-
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study of the possibility of having commercial airlines and
6 railroads establish reduced fares for elderly persons at non-
7 peak travel times.
