RESOLVE, PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PREPARATION OF PLANS FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representa-
3 tives, the commissioner of education or his designee, the com-
4 missioner of commerce and development or his designee, and
5 four persons to be appointed by the governor, of whom one
6 shall represent organized labor and one the Massachusetts
7 Association of School Committees, one shall be an architect
8 specializing in the use of wood, and one an architect specializ-
9 ing in the use of steel and concrete, is hereby established for
10 the purpose of making an investigation and study of the prep-
11 aration of plans for school buildings to be made available to
12 all cities and towns.

By the Senate, a resolution of John D. Hunter that provision be made for the transportation and supply for a special commission consisting of five members of the Senate to be appointed by the President for the purpose of investigating the administration of the Government.
