AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VACATION OF STATE EMPLOYEES WITH  
TWENTY YEARS' SERVICE OR MORE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section twenty-eight of chapter seven of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding at the end of said section the following sentence: —  
4 Said rules shall provide that employees of the commonwealth  
5 with twenty or more years' service shall be granted vacation  
6 leave of five weeks and employees with twenty-five or more  
7 years' service shall be granted vacation leave of six weeks,  
8 and employees with thirty or more years' service shall be  
9 granted vacation leave of seven weeks.
