AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS TO INCREASE THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF CERTAIN FORMER EMPLOYEES RETIRED ON SUPERANNUATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section 90C the words: — This section shall specifically apply to persons retired under section 58 of 4 said Chapter 32 of the General Laws.

By the Bureau, a section of General Orders and the section of
