AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE JOB GROUP OF FIELD INVESTIGATORS, IN  
THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
- 2 law to the contrary, the position of field investigator, in the
- 3 division of employment security is hereby placed in Job Group
- 4 15 in said division and the director of the division of employ-
- 5 ment security is hereby authorized to place all present in-
- 6 cumbents of such positions in this grade.
