In the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE FOSTER GRANDPARENT PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 There is hereby established within the department of elder  
2 affairs a state agency termed the "State Foster Grandparent  
3 Program" to be staffed by persons who have attained the age  
4 of sixty or above whose income is nineteen hundred dollars  
5 for a single person or twenty-five hundred dollars for a mar-  
6 ried couple to act as surrogate grandparents for children in  
7 various state institutions. Each foster grandparent shall re-  
8 ceive a stipend of one dollar and sixty cents an hour. In the  
9 city of Boston, the ABCD agency shall be the employing  
10 agency.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE FOSTER GRANDPARENT PROGRAM.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Town  
 Court assembled, and by the authority of the State, as follows:

1. There is hereby established within the department of elder  
 affairs a state agency termed the "State Foster Grandparent  
 Program" to be staffed by persons who have attained the age  
 of sixty or more whose income is not over hundred dollars  
 for a single person or two hundred dollars for a mar-  
 ried couple to act as surrogate grandparents for children in  
 various state institutions. Each foster grandparent shall re-  
 ceive a stipend of one dollar and sixty cents an hour. In the  
 city of Boston, the AED agency shall be the employing  
 agency.
