AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS ON THE BOARD OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out the first paragraph of section 33 (a) as most
3 recently amended by section 11 of chapter 1099 of the acts
4 of 1971, and inserting in place thereof the following para-
5 graph: —
- 6 (a) There shall be a board of public accountancy, in this
7 section and in sections thirty-four and thirty-five called the
8 board, consisting of six members to be appointed by the gov-
9 ernor. Each member shall be a citizen of the commonwealth.
10 Five of the members shall hold a valid biennial permit issued
11 under section eighty-seven B of chapter one hundred and
12 twelve and shall have been actively engaged on his own ac-
13 count or as a member of a partnership in the practice of public
14 accountancy for at least seven years. Four of the members
15 shall be certified public accountants holding certificates issued
16 under section eighty-seven A of chapter one hundred and
17 twelve, or under prior laws of the commonwealth, and the
18 fifth member shall be a public accountant registered under the
19 laws of the commonwealth. The sixth member shall be a
20 representative of the public, subject to the provisions of sec-
21 tion nine B.
